**Day 1:** Arrival in Kathmandu (1,300 m/4,264 ft)

**Day 2:** Scenic Mt. Everest Flight and Kathmandu Sightseeing

**Day 3:** Fly to Pokhara and trek to Ulleri (2050 m/6725 ft): 30 min flight and 6 hours trek

**Day 4:** Ulleri to Ghorepani (2750 m/ 9020 ft): 4 - 5 hours trek

**Day 5:** Ghorepani to Poon Hill to Tadapani (2,700m/8,860 ft): 6 - 7 hours

**Day 6:** Tadapani to Ghandruk (1,940m/6,360 ft): 3 - 4 hours

**Day 7:** Ghandruk to Pokhara (823m/2,700ft): 4-hour trek and 1-hour's drive

**Day 8:** Sightseeing in Pokhara

**Day 9:** Drive from Pokhara to Chitwan (815 m/2,674 ft): 134km/4-5 hours

**Day 10:** Chitwan National Park

**Day 11:** Drive from Chitwan to Kathmandu: 127km, 4-5 hours

**Day 12:** Final Departure
