


Gokyo Lake Trekking

Experiencing the Himalayan Glaciers can be achieved as you go trekking. Yes! Trekking to the Gokyo lake for 13 days is a kind of adventure that you will surely never forget. Imagine the scenic views and relaxing in a place that is breathtaking is something that you do not want to miss out. Seeking for a mountain trekking fun is indeed sounds exciting especially for those who love to go out hiking and camping. Mountaineers would always go for a place that may look challenging but not to the point of risking a life.

Aiming for a mountain geographical view, take the Gokyo Lake Trekking for 13 days. This is located in the Sagarmatha Zone at the Northeastern Nepal. This is also known as the Dudh Pokhari in which Gokyo lies in the village on the eastern part of the shore along with the other neighboring places within. This has the freshest water source to its mainstream that is coming from the northwest towards the origin of Ngozumpa Glacier that is found in the east. Regarding the deepest lakes, Gokyo lake is second, that follows the Thonak Co or the fourth lake. However, the Gokyo lake is vulnerable, ecologically fragile and it is found to be an unstable zone. The glacier of the Ngozumpa is threatening as well once it will outburst to the existing lakes.

If you are wholeheartedly seeking for a spiritual peace, Gokyo lake trekking for 13 days is your best choice for you to experience a vast

solitude. It is popular with the route of flowers and fauna most especially in the months of March to April. This is considered as the sacred place for Hindus and Buddhists. This place is said to have a symbolic meaning when it comes to spiritual encounter and worship in accordance with their belief. Its tourism has led many tourists to take a tour and also experience the Gokyo lake trekking 13 days. Going out camping at Gokyo is possible. If you are planning to do trekking and camping, do not forget your tools for camping as you will be trekking for 13 days with different sites in the midst of Gokyo lake. Most trekking offers are in the months of September to December for a mountain view.

In comparison to the Everest base camp, Gokyo lake is one of the places that is commonly visited, hiked and trekked by people. Regarding trekking, there are two variations that you can choose whether you want to have a flower view in the months of February to July and during the normal seasons on June to July. Put your plans ahead of time which includes setting for a tour guide. Aside from these, you should also be prepared regarding your budget, so it would best to save money and at the same time inquire for the prices available if there is any package tour. Keep in mind that your convenience should be entertained.

Day 1: Arrive in Kathmandu (1300 m/4264 ft)

Day 2: Kathmandu: Sightseeing and trek preparation

Day 3: Fly to Lukla (2,800 m/9,184 ft), trek to Phakding (2,652 m/8,700 ft): 3 - 4 hours

Day 4: Phakding to Namche Bazaar (3,440 m/11,283 ft): 5 - 6 hours

Day 5: Namche Bazaar: acclimatization

Day 6: Namche Bazaar to Phorse (3810 m/ 12,496 ft): 5 - 6 hours

Day 7: Phorse Village to Machhermo-(4,470 m/ 14,663 ft): 5 - 6 hours

Day 8: Machharmo to Gokyo (4800 m/15,744 ft): 5 - 6 hours

Day 9: Gokyo Valley: Climb Gokyo Ri (5357 m/17,570 ft) and hike to fifth lakes: 5 - 6 hours

Day 10: Gokyo to Dole: 3 - 4 hours

Day 11: Dole to Lukla

Day 12: Fly to Kathmandu

Day 13:Final Departure
